Biology 363/463 Release form

The purpose of this release form is to document that you have read and understand the hygienic practices that need to be used when working with zebrafish embryos, larva, and adult fish.

During laboratories that use bleached embryos and larva, you must:

- 1. Wear latex or nitrile gloves at all times
- 2. Wear a face mask to prevent water from inadvertently getting into your mouth
- 3. Wash your hands with antimicrobial soap at the end of class and whenever you are taking a break from working directly with the embryos/larva.
- 4. Wipe the surfaces of your microscope(s) with 10% bleach, and place any tools used (forceps, etc., in a 10% bleach solution).

During laboratories that use adult fish, you must:

- 1. Wear latex or nitrile gloves at all times
- 2. Wear a face mask to prevent water from inadvertently getting into your mouth
- 3. Wash your hands with antimicrobial soap at the end of class and whenever you are taking a break from working directly with the fish.
- 4. Place the nets you used directly into netdip for disinfection.
